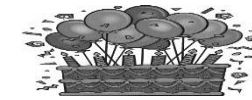

SCENIC HILLS QUILT SHOW

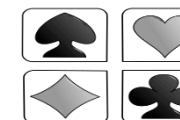

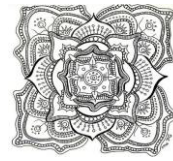

We start at 6:30PM or as close to that as we can get...SEE YOU THERE...

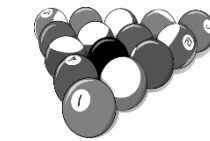


We gather between 6:15 – 6:45 every Wednesday night, depending on when the 'out to eat' group returns.



READING CLUB

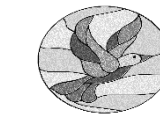
