#### **CART PATH SAFETY INITIATIVE UPDATE**

We are taking important steps to address the condition of our sidewalks and cart paths to ensure safety, accessibility, and financial stability for our community. Here's what we're doing to tackle this issue:

Professional Assessment - We've engaged professionals to evaluate the sidewalks and cart paths. They will provide a detailed report on the necessary repairs or potential removals. Once the evaluation is complete, we'll share the findings with the community.

Prioritizing Repairs - Our focus will be on the most hazardous areas first, addressing tripping risks and steep slopes. Repairs are planned to begin in 2025, ensuring we have adequate time to plan and allocate resources. We be using our limited funds designated in our Reserve for these repairs and those in the future.

Temporary Safety Measures - While permanent repairs are planned, we'll install warning signs or barriers in high-risk areas to reduce immediate dangers.

Community Updates - We are committed to keeping you informed about the progress and importance of these efforts to ensure safety and accessibility for all residents.

Insurance Review - We're reviewing our insurance coverage to confirm it adequately protects against potential accidents in these areas and addressing any gaps.

Your safety and well-being remain our top priorities. Thank you for your continued support and understanding as we work to make Scenic Hills safer and more secure for everyone.

# **RENTING SCENIC HILLS FACILITIES**

The Board has explored various strategies to generate additional revenue through facility rentals. After thorough evaluation, the Board has chosen to maintain the current resident-exclusive rental model. This approach ensures operational costs are covered without generating a surplus, aligning with SHCA's commitment to affordability and accessibility for all residents.

While the possibility of renting facilities to external parties was considered, it was ultimately deemed impractical due to significant legal, financial, and staffing challenges. These challenges include liability risks, substantial program setup costs, and increased strain on limited resources, which collectively outweigh the potential benefits.

The Board remains dedicated to identifying alternative revenue opportunities that align with the community's values and operational capabilities. Our focus will continue to prioritize efficiency, transparency, and the well-being of our residents.

#### **IRRIGATION**

During the Public Board of Directors Meeting Tuesday, December 17, 2024, SPP 4.11, Requesting Additional Irrigation was approved. As noted in a recent email blast, enhancements were made to the program. Participants will receive priority for resident system repairs. In December we had 23 work orders put in with 22 completed. That's 662 for the year with 42 open work orders.

Applications are available online on the SHCA website or in person with Jerriann. All applications must be submitted in person or via email to Jerriann with samples and detailed description.

In 2024, 61 ACC applications were received and processed with only 4 being declined. Thank you to all our residents for providing such

detailed information on your application. It made the decision process a smooth one.

## UPDATE ON SCENIC HILLS - FACILITIES PROJECTS

The attached project list gives account of what has been done, in consideration of pursuing, and essential repairs required to maintain operations.

- 1. Installed gazebo light & outlet (NO cost to community).
- 2. Installed new "Welcome" sign to the lodge (NO cost to community).
- 3. Repaired & ensured all exterior electrical boxes are functional.
- 4. Pursuing insurance settlement for Mimosa. Need to get new proposals for an updated repair plan.
- 5. Discussed expansion of storage in enclosed area behind the kitchen for better use for decorations, furniture, etc.
- 6. Discussed possible expansion and inclusion of storage containers within the RV lot.
- 7. Discussed possible change of lights at the RV lot and guardhouse.
- 8. Informed that work has started repairing support posts on the shuffleboard shelters.
- 9. We are pursuing bids for attic insulation at the lodge.
- 10. Discussed a plan of action for getting electric resolution at the gate entry walls for new lighting.
- 11. Getting sidewalk assessment on condition and essential needs to pursue for safety.
- 12. Getting bids for sewer line repairs from kitchen out to main line.
- 13. Getting GVEC electrical to run new power lines to Ballroom A/C units (currently these lines are destroyed from shorting out).
